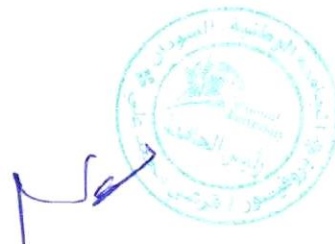

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ON FRIENDSHIP AND COOPERATION, PROMOTION OF MUTUAL UNDERSTANDING, ACADEMIC, CULTURAL AND SCIENTIFIC THOUGHT AND PERSONNEL EXCHANGE

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred as “MOU”) is executed BETWEEN

NATIONAL UNIVERSITY – SUDAN (hereinafter referred to as “NUSU”) is a private higher education institution, established in 2005 as the “ National College for Medical and Technical Studies” upgraded to “University” in October 2013. It is located in the Sudan, Capital Khartoum.

AND

ADAL MEDICAL UNIVERSITY- SOMALI is a private higher education institution, established in 2015. It is located in the Awdal Capital Borama- North Somali.

(hereinafter to as singularly as “ the party” and collectively as “ Parties”)

WHEREAS

- A. NUSU is the first and only ISO- certified higher education institution in Sudan, in areas of quality management of academic programmes of medicine, pharmacy, dentistry, physiotherapy, radiographic sciences and health informatics,. The graduate of NUSU are recognized in USA, UK, and Europe and Gulf Countries.
- B. ADAL MEDICAL UNIVERSITY is the first and only Medical Sciences higher education institution in Sudan, in areas medicine and surgery, optometry, medical laboratory Science, Nursing and midwifery, public health and human nutrition sciences.

ARTICLE 1

OBJECTIVE

The parties, subject to the terms of this Memorandum of Understanding and the laws, rules, regulation and national policies from time to time in force in each party, country, shall

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endeavour to strengthen, promote and develop in ternational ad research co-opration between the parties on the basis of equality ad mutual benefit.

ARTICLE 2

AREAS OF COORPORATION

2.1 Both parties agree to encourage the following activities, in particular, to promote international academic cooporation in the following areas:

1. Promotion of institutional exchanges between faculty, staff and student from each partner institution.
2. Acceptance of undergraduate and graduate students from each partner institution for periods of study and/or research;
3. Organization of Symposia, conferences, short coursesand meeting on research issues;
4. Exchange of information pertianing to developments in teaching student development and research institution;
5. Benchmarking and peer reviews:
 - a) Curriculum development and evaluation.
 - b) Assessments.
 - c) External examiners.
 - d) Reviewers.
 - e) Trianing of teaching staff
 - I. Learning outcome
 - II. Curriculum design

 - a) Exchange of medical teaching staff.
 - b) Secondment of medical docors: physicians, specialists and consultants (short and long terms).

- 11. Adal medical university will benefit from the experience of NUSU in the process of becoming a member of QS top universities database a (QS World Universities Ranking).
- 2.2 For the purpose of implementing the co-operation in respect of any areas stated in paragraph 2.1 the Parties shall enter into legally binding agreement subject to terms and conditions as mutually agreed upon by the parties including clauses on “confidentiality”, “suspension”, “protection of intellectual property rights” and “settlement of disputes”.

ARTICLE 3

FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

- 3.1 This Memorandum of Understanding shall not give rise to any financial obligation by one party to the other.
- 3.2 Each party shall bear its own cost and expenses in the implementation of this Memorandum of Understanding.

ARTICLE 4

EFFECT OF MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding serves only as record of the parties, intentions and does not constitute or create, obligations under domestic or international law and shall not



give rise to any legal process and shall not be deemed to constitute or create any legally binding or enforceable obligations, express or implied.

ARTICLE 5

NO AGENCY

Nothing contained herein is to be construed so as to constitute a joint venture partnership or formal business organisation of any kind between the parties or so to constitute either party as agent of the other.

ARTICLE 6

ENTRY INTO EFFECT AND DURATION

- 6.1 This Memorandum of Understanding shall become effective as of the date of signatures of both parties, or if the dates vary, then the date of the later signature.
- 6.2 This Memorandum of Understanding shall remain in effect for a period of FIVE (5) years.
- 6.3 This Memorandum of Understanding may be extended for such further period as may be agreed in writing by both parties.
- 6.4 if this Memorandum of Understanding is not renewed by mutual consent, Memorandum of Understanding shall conclude at the end of the specified period, or after activities in progress have concluded.

ARTICLE 7

REVISION, VARIATION AND AMENDMENT

- 7.1 Either party may request in writing a revision or amendment of this Memorandum of Understanding.
- 7.2 Any such revision, or amendment agreed to by the parties shall be in writing and shall form part of this Memorandum of Understanding shall.

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7.3 such revision, variation or amendment shall come into force on such date as may be determined by the parties.

7.4 Any revision, variation or amendment shall not prejudice the implementation of any project, activity or co-operation arising from or based on this Memorandum of Understanding shall before or up to the date of such revision, variation or amendment.

ARTICLE 8

TERMINATION

This Memorandum of Understanding may be terminated by either party with a minimum of Thirty (30) days written notice. Activities in progress at the time of termination of this Memorandum of Understanding shall be permitted to conclude as planned unless otherwise agreed.

ARTICLE 9

IMPLEMENTATION MECHANISM

9.1 The two Parties agreed to constitute a working committee THREE (3) member for each party for coordination, collaboration and implementation of the Memorandum of Understanding.

9.2 The committee will be held twice a year alternately.

ARTICLE 10

NOTICES

Any communication under this Memorandum of Understanding shall be in writing in English language and delivered by registered mail to the address or sent to the electronic mail address or facsimail number of NATIONAL UNIVERSITY SUDAN or ADAL MEDICAL UNIVERSITY SOMALI as the case may be, shown below or to each address or electronic mail address or facsimail number as either party may have notified the other party and shall, unless otherwise provided herein, be deemed to be duly given or made when delivered to the recipient at such address or electronic mail address or or facsimail number which is duly acknowledged.
