MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between

WSL ORGANIZATION, SWEDEN

And

NATIONAL UNIVERSITY, KHARTOUM, SUDAN

This **MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING** is made on the ^{10th} of ^{Sep.} Year 2014.

The Memorandum of Understanding between WSL Organization Sweden/Sudan (hereinafter referred to as **WSL**) being the first party and National University (hereinafter referred to as **NU**), Khartoum being the second party, provides for the establishment of an academic and training cooperation between the two parties.

Recognizing the value of promoting mutual cooperation for the advancement of knowledge, capacity building, skills acquisition and intellectual development, WSL organization and NU agree with the following general guideline and procedures:

Article I

1.0 The cooperation involves collaboration between WSL and NU:

- 1.1 **Consultancies agreements:** the two parties may involve in consultancy services, technical educational, academic, or administrative as the case may be.
- 1.2 **Under and Post-graduate admission scheme:** the NU may give all Students sponsored by WSL priority in admission, provided that they fulfill the condition of the ministry of higher education in Sudan for University placement and the NU standards. The NU may treat WSL students as local students in connection with fees structure.
- 1.3 **Exchange of Staffs:** exchange of staffs between the two parties may take place on programs that will be of mutual benefit. Such exchanges may involve teaching, training, research or a study visit and academic development. The duration of stay shall be decided by the concerned.
- 1.4 **Exchange of Materials:** the two parties may facilitate the exchange of technology, equipment and academic materials for training and research.
- 1.5 **Short Courses and Training Programs:** the two parties may agree to conduct short courses or training programs for a duration to be agreed upon, subject to the approval of the appropriate authorities in each institution.

Article II

2.0 Procedure of Exchange:

2.1 Details of each exchange program shall be arranged through the relevant quarters of both parties subject to the approval of the appropriate authorities in each institution. In any exchange procedure, it may not necessarily be simultaneously reciprocal as WSL Organization is mainly financier and coordinator.

2.1.1 Consultancy programs: - Educational, academic, and technological consultancies.

- Conducting joint educational, technological and research programs.

- Conducting specialized training sessions.

2.1.2 Students' admission scheme: through WSL scholarship program and NU facilities.

2.1.3 Staff exchange: short visit, training resource persons, technology, transfer experts.

2.1.4 Short courses

2.1.5 Training for MSc and PhD

2.1.6 Research projects

2.1.7 Split programs: under and post-graduate

2.1.8 Exchange programs for students: through the Swedish Universities, other University and Institutes and National University.

3.0 Financial Arrangements:

- 3.1 The principle which both institutions will adopt is based on cost recovery for both activities where appropriate. In specific cases, the commitment to funding costs would be agreed to on a case by case basis.
- 3.2 The expenses arising from the cooperation, as for example, training or advisory visits or staff attachments etc, will be negotiated according to the mutual acceptance of both parties.

Article IV

4.0 Validity and Termination of the Memorandum of Understanding:

- 4.1 The Memorandum of Understanding shall be valid for Five years and may be amended upon mutual agreement of both parties. Either party may terminate this understanding by informing the other party six months in advance. The Memorandum of Understanding may be extended after five years subject to mutual agreement of both parties. In the event of termination of Memorandum of Understanding, the provisions of the Memorandum shall continue to apply to ongoing programs until their completions.
