WORK EXPERIENCE:

I completed the pre-fellowship training in General Surgery in Khartoum and Riyadh Central Hospital, The tow largest teaching hospitals in Sudan and Saudi Arabia with Over 1,000 bed each.

I continued to gain experience in clinical and operative surgery in the Military Hospital (RKH) in Riyadh, a centre of excellence of high reputation in Saudi Arabia And the Middle East.

After moving to the UK in February, 1994, I gained wide experience in General Surgery and become confident in <u>bowel and laparoscopic surgery</u>, particularly <u>laparoscopic</u> <u>cholecystectomy and Laparoscopic hernia repair</u>. My experience consolidated further in upper and lower GIT <u>endoscopy</u>.

In February, 1995, I joined the Northern Deanery Higher Surgical Training Programme where I continued to gain more confidence and operative experience in <u>General Surgery</u> and to extend this to include <u>Vascular Surgery</u> in both elective and emergency cases as well as <u>Endocrine Surgery</u> (*thyroid & parathyroid surgery*)

Then I moved to <u>Transplantation</u> where I gained a wide exposure in liver transplantation, Hepato-biliary & Pancreatic Surgery, and a consolidated experience in <u>Adult and Paediatric Renal Transplantation</u> both cadaveric, living related/unrelated and transplants from non-heart beating donors, as well as access surgery for haemo-&peritoneal dialysis and multi-organ retrieval including <u>laparoscopic donor nephrectomy</u>. I managed to combine this experience in renal transplantation with more experience in <u>vascular & endocrine surgery</u> by moving to the Northern Vascular Centre at the Freeman Hospital where I received an intense training in vascular surgery to include aortic and bypass surgery in both elective and emergency cases. Also I had the chance to gain a considerable experience in <u>endocrine surgery (thyroid & parathyroid surgery)</u> <u>and laparoscopic surgery</u>

Finally at the end of my training I passed the Intercollegiate Specialty Examination in General Surgery. <u>(Subspecialty-General Surgery andTransplant)</u>, to obtain the <u>FRCS</u> <u>(Gen-Surg)</u>, and the certificate of completion of specialist surgical training (CCST).</u>

Currently I am working as a <u>consultant General and Renal transplant Surgeon</u>. In addition to the common surgical operations, I do a regular list in <u>laparoscopic surgery</u>, particularly laparoscopic cholecystectomy, hernia repair, In addition to participation at different stages of laparoscopic donor nephrectomy as part of our live donor programme, and <u>endocrine surgery</u> mainly thyroid and parathyroid. I have a large interest in <u>Access Surgery</u> and I am taking a lead part in provision of haemo-&-peritoneal access procedures in renal failure patients as well as all forms of renal transplantation both in adult and paediatric group. I am a <u>clinical teacher and examiner, Honorary Lecturer</u> at the Nottingham University during my work in the UK and **examiner** for the Intercollegiate **MRCS** examinations at the Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh, UK centers and overseas (Khartoum Center)

I spent a period of two years of research into the clinical outcome and patient satisfaction following balloon angioplasty of the superficial femoral artery in patients with lower limb ischaemia.
