The Policy and Procedure

Application Procedure:

- An individual, department, or the faculty can nominate an adjunct professor. The nomination is discussed and approved by the department and faculty board and raised to the University President.
- The nominated adjunct professor should have at least 20 years of experience and a record of significant scientific contributions, including international awards.
- The University should issue an invitation letter to invite the nominee to join.
- The nominee should submit an acceptance letter, with an updated CV, and a photo.
- Departments and faculties coordinate roles and activities. However, teaching and scholarly activities are central to their roles.

The Expected Duties and Responsibilities

- Teach assigned courses, develop syllabi and assessments, and provide feedback.
- Contribute to curriculum design and quality assurance; create instructional materials.
- Maintain an active scholarly or professional agenda; publish and collaborate on research.
- Participate in department/university service and community engagement; assist with accreditation.
- Affiliate as NUSU staff in the relevant publications
- Handle administrative duties and collaborate across disciplines.
- Engage in community or international outreach and external representation.

Duration of Appointment

An adjunct professor is appointed for three years, which is renewable upon agreement.

Recognition and Remuneration

- i. The University will celebrate the enrollment of the adjunct professor at a special ceremony.
- ii. The adjunct professor will receive a certificate of recognition and appreciation at the end of their period.
