

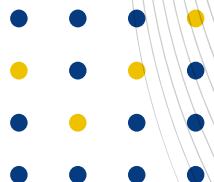

These mechanisms ensure inclusiveness in decision-making and foster a culture of dialogue, equality, and mutual respect. The university's policies on academic integrity, anti-corruption, and non-discrimination further strengthen institutional justice and ethical conduct among staff and students.

Academically, the Faculty of International Relations and Diplomatic Studies, established in 2016, advances peace-oriented education by focusing on conflict resolution, diplomacy, global gover-

nance, and international law. Research and seminars conducted under this faculty address topics such as post-conflict reconstruction, peacebuilding in Africa, and human rights advocacy—empowering students to become active contributors to national and regional stability.

NUSU also promotes civic awareness through student-led initiatives, workshops, and community dialogues that encourage tolerance, diversity, and peaceful coexistence. During periods of national unrest, the university has prioritized the safety and well-being of its community, demonstrating leadership and resilience by maintaining academic continuity through satellite centres and digital learning platforms.

Collaborations with local and international partners further enhance the university's role in strengthening institutional capacity and promoting justice. Engagement in academic networks such as the Association of African Universities and the International Association of Universities supports governance training and policy exchange initiatives.

Through these actions, NUSU actively contributes to building peaceful, inclusive, and accountable societies—reflecting its core belief that education is a cornerstone of sustainable peace and strong institutions.
